Applications for DDTP Funding of Speech Generating Devices (SGDs) are now available.

The CPUC, as part of its Deaf and Disabled Telecommunications Program (DDTP), provides last-resort funding for Speech Generating Devices (SGDs). This last-resort funding is available after MediCal, Medicaid, and other applicable insurance has been pursued.

The SGDs covered by this application are those identified as durable medical equipment by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. To qualify for this program, the SGDs must meet the applicant's needs for access to, and use of, the telephone network based on evaluation by and the recommendation of an SLP.
