Level 2

Business Considerations:

- Resources required to deploy broadband
- Strengths/weaknesses of different technologies

Technology Talks:

- Funding strategies and fundamentals of finance
- Intro to business plans

Policies and Tools:

- Asset mapping and identifying peer networks
- Timeline for accessing grant opportunities

Level 3

Business Considerations:

- Business plans, financial modeling, forecasting
- Marketing and strategic planning

Technology Talks:

- Best practices for deploying broadband
- IRUs, pole attachments, easements, etc.

Policies and Tools:

- Using the Federal Funding Account + Loan Loss Reserve
- Data collection, mapping, and reporting requirements
