In accordance with California's Digital Infrastructure and Video Competition Act ("DIVCA"), General Order 169 and the Decision 14-08-057 Amending General Order 169 to Implement the Franchise Renewal Provisions of the Digital Infrastructure and Video Competition Act of 2006, Falcon Telecable, a California Limited Partnership hereby submits the enclosed state video franchise renewal application and supplemental data for the above-referenced franchisee.
