IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT REINSTATEMENT FROM REVOCATION

When you submit this Form PL 702 and pay the \$125 reinstatement fee for each authority, your authority(ies) will not necessarily be reinstated immediately. Before the License Section reinstates your authority(ies), it must confirm all of the following:

1. That you have all required insurance on file with the License Section, and that no required insurance is due to be cancelled within 30 days. It is advisable to check with your insurer(s) when, or before, you submit this form;
2. That if you operate vehicles with a seating capacity of more than 10, including the driver, payment of Annual Bus Inspection fees is current. Use Forms PL664 (Equipment Statement/Inspection Request) and PL739-B (Terminal Inspection Fee Statement) if necessary;
3. That you have paid all PUCTRA fees and penalties owed, not just the quarter or year for which you may have been suspended and revoked;
4. That you have no outstanding balance due to the Commission;
5. That if the authority(ies) was/were issued to a corporation, limited liability company or limited partnership, it is active and in good standing with the office of the California Secretary of State;
6. That you have paid, or are paying timely, any fines imposed by the Enforcement Section, and that it has no objection to the reinstatement of your authority(ies).

Only if the License Section finds no deficiencies in any of the above areas will it reinstate your authority(ies). Normally, this will require no more than 5 business days to confirm. However, if the License Section does find any deficiencies, it will notify you in writing, including what you must do to correct the deficiency(ies). This notice will include a deadline, approximately 60 days, by which time you must correct all deficiencies in order to be reinstated. If you fail to correct all deficiencies by that deadline, you must reapply and pay the appropriate application fee, as shown in the table below. This table also reflects the refile application fee you must pay if you fail to apply for reinstatement within 90 days of the date of revocation.
