Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 454.9 and Resolution E-3238 dated July 24, 1991, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC hereby gives the Commission notice that it is booking costs into its Catastrophic Event Memorandum Account (CEMA). These costs are in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
