PURPOSE

In accordance with Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 591, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp), submits in information-only Advice Letter (AL) 586-E its 2018 Interim Risk Spending Accountability Report (Report). The Report is provided as Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND

On May 31, 2019, PacifiCorp submitted its Report to Michael Zelazo with the Energy Division in response to his April 23, 2019 request for information. On June 4, 2019, Mr. Zelazo requested PacifiCorp submit its Report as an information-only AL with the Energy Division's Tariff Unit.
