PURPOSE

In accordance with Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 591,¹ PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp), submits in information-only Advice Letter (AL) 622-E its 2019 Interim Risk Spending Accountability Report (Report). The Report is provided as Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND

In April 2019, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued Decision 19-04-020 (Decision), Phase Two Decision Adopting Risk Spending Accountability Report Requirements and Safety Performance Metrics for Investor-Owned Utilities and Adopting a Safety Model Approach for Small and Multi-Jurisdictional Utilities (SMJUs). The Decision orders the SMJUs to file their first Risk Spend Accountability Reports (RSARs) following authorization in the General Rate Case (GRC) proceedings.

On April 12, 2018, PacifiCorp filed its most recent GRC application (A.) 18-04-002 and the Commission issued final Decision 20-02-025 in the proceeding on February 18, 2020. Therefore, the company files this RSAR based on the company's previous GRC, Application 09-11-015, effective during the 2019 reporting period.

PROTESTS

Anyone wishing to protest this information-only AL may do so by letter sent via U.S. mail, by facsimile or electronically, any of which must be received no later than July 20, 2020. Protests should be mailed to:
