The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) submits the following Notice Of Probable Violations (NOPV) for non-DOT reportable incident investigations completed in the First (1st) Quarter of 2019. This letter serves as notification to you that as a result of our investigations, SED found Southwest Gas Corporation (SWG) in violation of the following:

Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §192.605(b)(1) states in part:

"(b) Maintenance and normal operations. The manual required by paragraph (a) of this section must include procedures for the following, if applicable, to provide safety during maintenance and operations."

"(1) Operating, maintaining, and repairing the pipeline in accordance with each of the requirements of this subpart and subpart M of this part."

The summary of the identified violation is listed in Attachment A of this letter. Please provide a written response within 30 days of the date of this letter indicating the measures taken by SWG to address the violation.
