Marysville District

What does D.20-12-007 Authorize for Cal Water?

Utility Revenue – Company Wide (21 Districts):

- Year 2020: \$696.5 million (M)
 - Increase of \$4.43M (0.6%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$717.4M and Year 2022*: \$738.8M
 O Increase of \$20.9M (3.0%) and \$21.4M (3.0%) respectively

Utility Revenue – Marysville District:

- Year 2020: **\$4.18M**
 - Increase of \$0.19M (4.8%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$4.33M and Year 2022*: \$4.41M
 O Increase of \$0.15M (3.5%) and \$0.08M (1.9%) respectively
